The limitation stated in the technical update TN-H8*-282A/EA will be applied if you use the E10A or E10A-USB emulator with the H8S/2218F and H8S/2212F group (hereinafter referred to as the H8S/2218F including the USB-boot versions). Due to this limitation, accessing the range of H'FFFF40 to H'FFFF5F, which is used as built-in RTC registers, etc., disables reading of the pin states of port D. In the E10A or E10A-USB emulator, a read operation occurs when the [IO] window is open as well as in execution of the program and thus the pin states of port D cannot be read.

[Problem]

If any of the following modules is selected in the [IO] window, the pin states of port D cannot be read.

- RTC (realtime clock)
- USB
- Low-power control

[Solution]

If you wish to open the [IO] window during debugging of the H8S/2218F and use port D to read its pin states, delete the extended module stop register (EXMDLSTP) in the [IO] window. For how to delete the register, see appendix D, I/O File Format, in the E10A or E10A-USB emulator user's manual.
